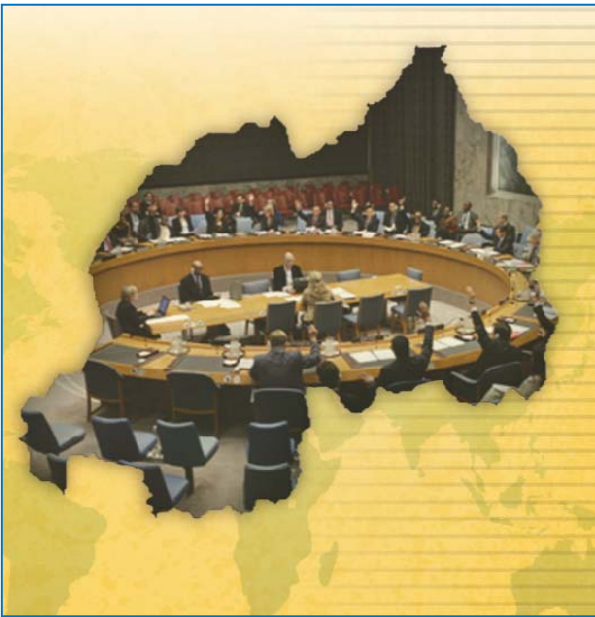

**Paul Rusesabagina:** Honored worldwide for saving Tutsis and Hutus alike, as depicted in the film *Hotel Rwanda*, recipient of the 2005 U.S. Presidential Medal of Freedom and the 2011 Lantos Human Rights Prize.

**Ambassador Robert Flaten:** U.S. Ambassador to Rwanda, 1990-93 witnessed the events leading up to the Burundi and Rwanda “genocides.” He directed State Department Offices of India, Pakistan, Afghanistan and lectures at St. Olaf College.

**Professor Peter Erlinder:** Professor of Law, WMCL; UN-ICTR Lead Defense Counsel; ICTR Defense Lawyers Association [ADAD] President; Director, International Humanitarian Law Institute ; former Rwandan political prisoner.
